



Chicago Figure Skating Club Skater Support Program

June 15, 2022

This program is for Chicago Figure Skating Club members who have been home club skaters for at least three (3) years.

Singles, Pairs, and Ice Dance Competitors

1. Skaters who compete in the National Qualifying Series will have one (1) entry fee reimbursed. Skaters who compete in multiple disciplines will have one (1) entry fee in each discipline reimbursed.
2. Skaters who compete in the Sectional Singles Final, the U.S. Pairs Final, or the U.S. Ice Dance Final will have at least \$250 of their expenses reimbursed.
3. Skaters who either compete in the U.S. Championships or who attend the National High Performance Development Team camp will have at least \$500 of their expenses reimbursed.
4. Skaters who compete for Team USA at an International (ISU) competition will have at least \$1,000 of their expenses reimbursed.

Each skater of a pair or dance couple is considered separately. (If only one member of the team is a CFSC home club member, then only that one skater is eligible for the program.)

Adult Competitors

1. Adult skaters who compete in a qualifying event at the Adult Sectional Figure Skating Championships will have their entry fee reimbursed.
2. Adult skaters who compete in a qualifying event at the U.S. Adult Figure Skating Championships will have at least \$250 of their expenses reimbursed.

Synchronized Skating Teams

1. Synchronized skating teams which compete in a qualifying event at the Synchronized Skating Sectional Championships will have their entry fee reimbursed.
2. Synchronized skating teams which compete in a qualifying event at the U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships will have at least \$500 of their expenses reimbursed.
3. Synchronized skating teams who compete for Team USA at an International (ISU) competition will have at least \$1,000 of their expenses reimbursed.

Theatre on Ice Teams

1. Theatre on Ice teams which compete at the National Theatre on Ice Competition will have their entry fee reimbursed.
2. Theatre on Ice teams which compete at the National Theatre on Ice Competition will have at least \$500 of their expenses reimbursed.

Skaters or teams must present proof of eligibility (e.g., official results) and copies of receipts for skating related expenses. Please help spread the word among coaches and parents of competitive skaters.
